### Meals

**Breakfast:** Continental breakfast with cooked breakfast twice a week.

**Lunch:** Choice of two main courses (1 vegetarian), salad bar and dessert.

**Dinner:** Choice of two main courses (1 vegetarian), salad bar and dessert.

### Accommodation

- Twin en-suite rooms within accommodation blocks located either side of the central Oxford International office.
- Accommodation is arranged in flats of 6 to 8 bedrooms or along corridors.
- Most blocks have a communal kitchen space or lounge where students can relax in the evening.

### Facilities

**Sports:** Sports centre with full size sports hall, allowing for activities such as basketball, volleyball and football. A fitness suite is available for Group Leaders with induction and fee.

**Other:** Set amongst beautiful Hampshire countryside this campus has spacious classrooms where the students also partake in drama and dance workshops as well as conversation clubs.

### Transport

#### Airports:

Heathrow: 1hr 20 min

Gatwick: 1hr 40 min

Groups are met at the airport by an Activity Leader who will welcome you and escort you to the campus.

**Nearest town:** Winchester, 17 minutes by taxi, 25 minutes by bus

**Coach:** 2hrs to central London

### Security

The accommodation is monitored 24-hours by a team of wardens and the university has staff that live on site in the case of emergency out-of-hours. Rooms can be locked so valuables such as passports and money can be stored in bedrooms. Damage deposits of £30 or €30 will be collected.
